# Step to Step Guide on Customizing Your Forum Profile

You can customize your Forum Profile with your Personal Information and adding a link or a banner to your Signature.

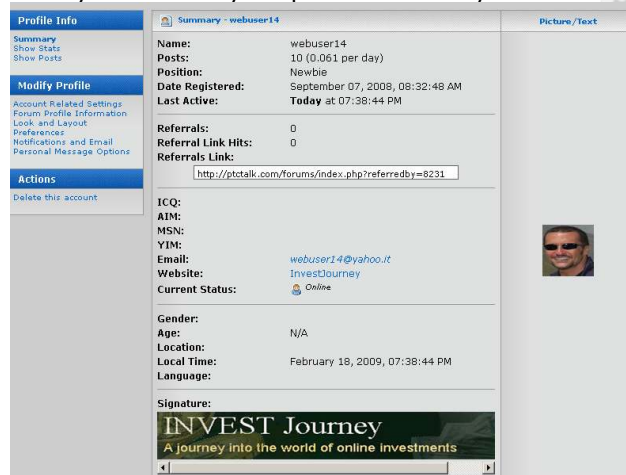
Those are the steps to add a banner to your signature (i used my PTCTalk Forum profile as a sample):

## 1. Login to your Account and Customize your Profile

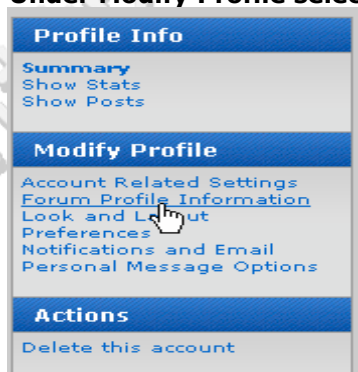
- Login to your Forum Account and select "Profile"



Here you can see your profile info. As you can see I have a Photo and a banner on my signature.



- Under Modify Profile select "Forum Profile Information"



- Change Your Profile information

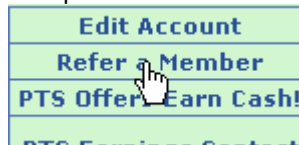
Here you can:

- Customize your Avatar adding a personalized picture (directly uploading or specifying an url where your image reside).
- Add your personal and contact information (Bitday date, msn account and so on)
- Add your Website Url and title
- **Modify your Signature.** To modify your signature those are the steps:
  - o Obtain the banner code you want to add to your signature (you can find this in your site backoffice. As an example I'll use the Neobux and Jillsclickcorner banner).
  - o Login to your site and go to banners section

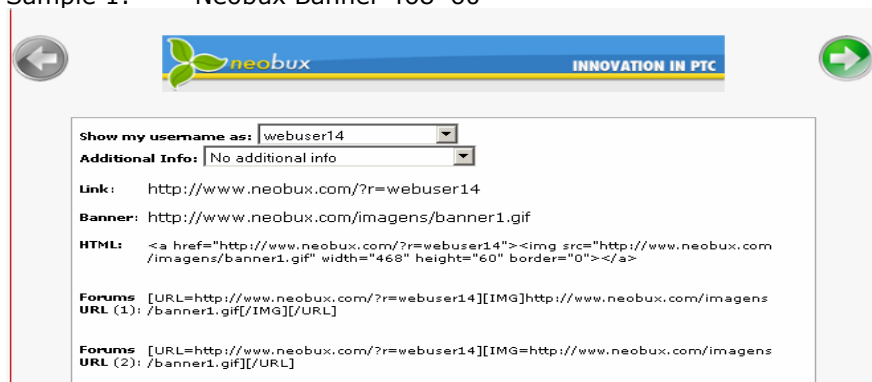

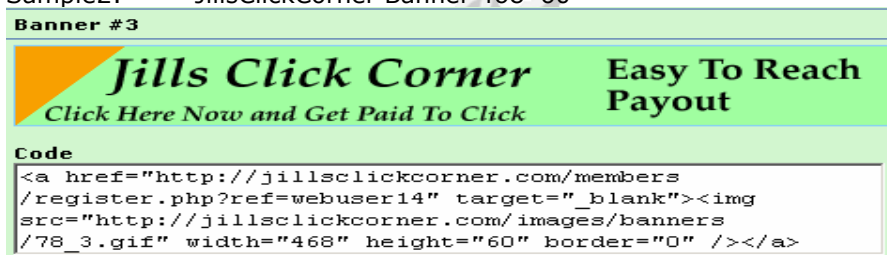


- o Choose the banners that you prefer (use a banner with width = "468" height= "60" or smaller as your signature):

Sample2: JillsClickCorner Banner 468\*60



A Banner has two different URLs:

**The Site URL** (sometimes called target URL); this is the url of the site containing your referral link:

**The Banner File URL**; this is the url of the Banner file in gif, jpg or png format

- o With those informations you can update your signature putting your Site Url and Banner File Url as shown below:
